



- Respect other people's property.
- Advocate for your local community.
- ► Get to know your neighbors and your neighborhood. (Block parties, saying 'hello,' watching out for each other)

- Support and defend the Constitution.
- Respect and obey federal, state, and local laws.
- Participate in the democratic process. <u>Cast</u> your VOTE!
- ► Pay income and other taxes honestly, and on time, to federal, state, and local authorities.
- Serve on a jury when called upon.
- Defend the country if the need should arise.

- Willingness to get involved; kids and adults!
- Willingness to volunteer your time and talents.
- Willingness to attend meetings and events.
- Willingness to be an ambassador for your community.
- Willingness to allow others to express themselves without judgement.
